Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

In August 2013, the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) adopted the final ruling regarding the sourcing of conflict minerals as defined in the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, Section 1502. This ruling requires all US companies to disclose to the SEC whether the products they manufacture or contract to manufacture contain "conflict minerals" that are necessary to the functionality or production of those products. The definition of "Conflict minerals" refers to minerals or other derivatives (specifically tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold) mined in the eastern provinces of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and nine adjoining countries: Republic of Congo, Central Africa Republic, South Sudan, Zambia, Angola, Tanzania, Burundi, Rwanda and Uganda.
